CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. **THE CHAMPIONSHIP:** The Peter Millar Queensland A, B & C Grade Championship will be played over 54 holes of Stableford play - 18 holes on each of Friday 26th, Saturday 27th and Sunday 28th November 2021. The entire field will contest all three rounds and the winners will be based on the best highest aggregate Stableford score.
2. **CHAMPIONSHIP COMMITTEE:** The Championship shall be under the management and control of a Championship Committee - the composition of this Committee to be determined by the venue club. The Championship Committee reserves the right to: (a) fix and/or alter starting times, (b) in the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, either shorten the contest or fix another day/venue, (c) vary any conditions should they deem it advisable, (d) reject any entry without assigning any reason therefore. The decision of the Championship Committee will be final in all matters and in the absence of a full committee, such members as may be present at the time may give a decision and any decision so given shall be deemed to be a decision of the full Championship Committee.
3. **ENTRIES:**
 - 3.1 The Peter Millar Queensland A, B & C Grade Championship is open to all male & female amateur golfers with a Golf Australia Handicap.
 - 3.2 The field will be limited to 240 players. To ensure your position in entering the field please register early to avoid disappointment.
 - 3.3 Entries must be received by Noosa Springs, Att: A, B & C Grade Championship, P.O. Box 54 Noosa Heads QLD 4567 at 5:00pm on Thursday 18th November 2021. For further information, please phone Noosa Springs on (07) 5440 3333.
 - 3.4 The prescribed Nomination Fee of \$339.00 (incl. GST) must accompany the nomination form at the time of nomination. Faxed telephone entries will only be accepted if payment is made by credit card (fax no: (07) 5440 3320).
 - 3.5 Do not send cash in the mail - Noosa Springs will not accept responsibility for cash sent that is not received.
 - 3.6 Entries without a Golf Link number must be endorsed by an official of the player's home club.
 - 3.7 Nominations are accepted at face value, on the basis that information contained therein is correct, and up to date. Should this subsequently be proven not to be the case, the Championship Committee reserves the right to deem any competitor ineligible - at any time prior to or during the Peter Millar Queensland A, B & C Grade Championship.
 - 3.8 Once the draw is completed there will be no refund of entry fees for players who withdraw from the event. Players who withdraw prior to the draw being published will be refunded their entry fee, less an administration fee of \$39.00.
4. **PUBLICITY:** Noosa Springs arranges publicity before, during and/or after this Championship. It is a condition of entry that all players assent to references to them, and pictures of them in practice and play being published via any medium (including the internet).
5. **PRIVACY:** Noosa Springs may retain the personal details (i.e. name, address, and handicap) of entrants in this Championship on its records. The purpose of doing so is such that information on other future events conducted by Noosa Springs (or other parties) can be forwarded as deemed appropriate by Noosa Springs. This information will not be available to any other organisation. Any person may have their details removed from this database by phoning Noosa Springs on (07) 5440 3333.
6. **DRESS REGULATIONS:** It is a requirement of this tournament that all players must comply with the dress standards of Noosa Springs. Players not conforming to the dress requirements of the course on which they are playing will not be permitted to take their place in the field.
7. **PRACTICE:** Practice rounds will be at the discretion of Noosa Springs, under whatever terms and conditions they determine. A limited number of practice rounds will be available on Thursday 25th November, at a cost of \$85.00 incl. cart. Bookings essential - phone (07) 5440 3333.
8. **RULES:** The Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews will apply together with such Local Rules as are approved by the Championship Committee.
9. **COURSE MARKERS:** During practice or during the Championship a player shall not place on the course, or cause to be placed on the course, any artificial marker or other device designed to indicate course measurements. A player in breach of this condition shall be disqualified.
10. **DRAW AND STARTING TIMES:** A draw for each day's play will be published. Players shall start at the time and in the order arranged by the Championship Committee. For the third round, an automatic draw will be conducted, based on the progressive aggregate scores for the first two rounds.
11. **BALL:** It will be obligatory for all competitors in the Championship to play with a ball which is named in the current R&A and/or USGA Approved Lists. Copies of these lists are available from www.randa.org or www.usga.org Penalty: Disqualification.
12. **USE OF MOTORIZED VEHICLES:** The tournament nomination fee includes cart fee.
13. **GPS:** Distance measuring devices may be used
14. **MOBILE PHONES:** The use of mobile phones by players and/or caddies for the purpose other than distance measuring during the play of any competition round, other than described in point 13 is prohibited.
15. **PACE OF PLAY:** will be strictly enforced. Players are expected to keep up with the group in front at all times, failure to comply may incur applicable penalties.
16. **TIES:** In the event of a tie for the Peter Millar Queensland A, B & C Grade Championship the winners will be determined by the use of the Australian Count-Back System.
17. **PROTESTS:** Protests must be lodged in writing with the Championship Committee no later than 10 minutes after the conclusion of the day's play.
18. **PRESENTATION OF TROPHIES:** Trophies will be presented at the conclusion of the Championship, and will be awarded at the determination of the Championship Committee.
